Zentoku-ji Temple

Founded by Rennyo Shō-nin 530 years ago. The temple's principal image is Amitabha Tathagata reportedly carved by the monk Gyoki. Valuable letters and treasures are on display in the repository.

A man-made lake with a 3km circumference. In spring, with full-bloomed thousands of cherry blossom trees, landscape is overwhelmingly beautiful here.
